PRESIDENT: The appeal fails. Do you wish any close on this matter? You move the adoption of Section 1?

SENATOR SCHMIT: I have, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Record. Mr. Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays to adopt Section 1.

PRESIDENT: Section 1 is adopted as an amendment to LB ... what is this bill number?

CLERK: 434.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I'm going to renew again my motion to adopt the balance of the Sections. I think that if there are amendments ... valid amendments to the Sections those amendments can be offered. I would be happy to receive them. I'm going to renew my motion to adopt the balance of the Sections.

PRESIDENT: Well that ... I'm afraid the Chair would have to rule that out of order because we have standing a ruling that the question shall be divided.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Then, Mr. President, I move to adopt Section 2. I'll proceed with the game as long as Senator Chambers wants to play it. When the body gets tired of it we'll take some other action.

PRESIDENT: You're asking... Are there five seconds? The question is shall debate cease on Section ... on Senator Schmit's motion to adopt Section 2. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on motion to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. The question before the House is the adoption of Section 2. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers, the amendments ... Section 2 is adopted. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, Sections 3 thru 9 are brief. Having read them there's nothing that I feel requires any discussion. So as far as my motion to separate the question, divide the question, those don't have to be handled in that fashion.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, would you move then the adoption of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I would so move, Mr. President.
