PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach. Mr. Speaker.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I erred in the agenda we have before us. In order to process and keep our work abreast with the bill drafter and the enrollment and review people, 434 should follow the other items on Select File and that we proceed with 434 after we have completed our Select File. That would make for more continuity and keep our bill drafter abreast of our work.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, I had a motion up there. Going by the schedule in front of us, I had assumed that we were going to take up 434 and I had a motion on 434 that I wanted to take up at this time, but if the order is going to be changed, I will just hold that.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All right. Senator Dworak, we are on Select.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a series of amendments. The first bill up is LB 690. The E & R amendments were adopted on March 19th which was Friday and the bill was laid over. I now have a series of additional amendments on it. The first amendment has no signature. Senator Barnett, is this yours that has a WB on it. Read amendment. See page 1265, Journal. Signed Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, it is over on Final. Is this right? We have to move it back?

CLERK: It is on Select.

SENATOR BARNETT: It is on Select. I can just amend it without moving it, then, right? Okay. I move for the adoption of this amendment and I might explain to the members present. This was what Senator George talked about wanting and we got together with Senator Goodrich and I believe Senator Shirley Marsh was involved in it. We come to the agreement with everybody that we would have a reporting about the raises, who they went to and this one paragraph will do it for both classified and non classified people. Otherwise we would have two sections in the bill. So Emory Burnett thought that if we drafted it this way we would include both people, both classified and non classified, asking for who gets the raises, how many of them get them, and what classifications there are, and I think I have talked to Senator George and Senator Goodrich and it has met with their approval so I would ask for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion. The question is the adoption of Senator Barnett's amendment to LB 690. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.
