

LB 690, 806

March 22, 1976

CLERK: Roll call vote taken.

PRESIDENT: Could we have it quieter so that the Clerk can hear.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. See pages 1268 and 1269, Journal. 25 ayes, 20 nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion is adopted, the amendment. We have in the North balcony from West Side High School forty Junior and Senior students. These students are from Senator Koch and Senator Stoney's Districts. Thank you for being here. We appreciate having student groups. There is a motion to raise the Call. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The Call is raised.

CLERK: There are no further amendments on 690.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: (Microphone off) now for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Swigart, you wanted to be recognized when the motion to move was made. All right. Senator Schmit.

CLERK: That is what is on right now, the motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: I know it but he.....

CLERK: Oh, okay.

PRESIDENT: The question then is the advancement of the bill. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, 806, there are E and R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to move to advance?

SENATOR DWORAK: I move that LB 806 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.
