

LB 1009, 1010

March 23, 1976

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. President, how many are excused?

CLERK: Two.

SENATOR LEWIS: I would ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the question now is shall the House go under Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 22 ayes, 16 nays.

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call. All Senators please return to your desks.

SENATOR LEWIS: I would ask for a roll call vote too Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright, record your presence please. Call the roll Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 22 ayes, 25 nays and 2 not voting.

PRESIDENT: You heard that motion, all in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The Call is raised. Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I change my vote from yes to nay for purposes of reconsideration.

PRESIDENT: Thank you Senator Savage. The bill fails to advance. LB 1010, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read LB1010

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, this bill appropriates \$500,000 to UNL for cost incurred in repairing the Plant Industry building. The insurance which was covered on this building is a \$500,000 deductible policy. Funds were taken from operation accounts to prepare the structure for school session. This replaces some of those funds, the total loss is not yet known, because the settlement has not yet been made with the insurance company. I move for the advancement of LB1010.

PRESIDENT: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, would Senator Marsh yield to a question? Senator Marsh is this money then going to be used to build a new building or does somebody try to use \$500,000 to do any repairs?

SENATOR MARSH: Senator, this will only be used to replace the funds which were used already to repair. It is not to build a new building, it is to make use of this building which had to be put into useable condition in a hurry.

SENATOR GEORGE: I understood that this was going to be replaced with a new building?
