By merely constructing an addition to this existing facility, rather than starting from scratch the State of Nebraska can save 1.9 million dollars. Now, actually if we don't take any action the bonds will not go into default at Peru before 1977. But, I think that this is the first step in meeting their needs for a physical education plant. I think that we should go ahead and advance this bill. If there are any questions I will try and answer them.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays and 11 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.
