SENATOR KEYES: Senator Cavanaugh, I have just one question for you. Senator Cavanaugh, in all the amendments that you've put on this bill it will not allow those who live in the SID district that do not own property to serve on the Board. Am I right? All who live on the property and do not ... live in the SID, but do not own property will not be able to serve on the Board?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Well we're providing for a condominium owners now.

SENATOR KEYES: Condominiums are where you own part of it.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: You have to have an interest in real estate, yes.

SENATOR KEYES: OK, bless you.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Or in a condominium.

PRESIDENT: Any other discussion? Alright the question is the adoption of Senator Cavanaugh's amendment. Record your vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Now.... You want to advance the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

We go to Resolutions.

CLERK: Read title to LR 136.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burrows.

SENATOR BURROWS: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. The Governor has sought this resolution with the progress that's been made by the Old West Commission. The planning has proceeded a long ways down the road. They're ready for quite a detailed planning to get in the actual close planning on the financing of the proposed veterinary college. The issue has come to this, if we don't give a resolution from this body, if we don't come forth with a resolution that's positive, that shows this Legislature wants a veterinary college - we're voting it down. If we back-pedal at all in the resolution we're going to vote down the veterinary concept. The Governor will be forced.... He cannot go to the Old West Regional Commission and ask these other states to work with him in a facility that will be built in this state unless we have a solid commitment.
