PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, did you wish to speak on this one? Senator Lewis, are you interested in this resolution? Alright then the question is the adoption of LR 160. Record your vote. Please vote. We just went under Call to get another resolution passed. Please vote on this one. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Resolution 162, Senator Cavanaugh's resolution.

CLERK: Read title to LR 162.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. This resolution was introduced on the request of the Transportation Committee of the Omaha Chamber of Commerce. I think it's self-explanatory. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I rise to support Senator Cavanaugh. I think it is an important resolution. I was wondering, Senator Cavanaugh, if in your closing ... not your closing. If you could give some thought on how we could amend the resolution so it would be applicable to say the next session of Congress also, just in case they don't get it done this year.

PRESIDENT: Could you respond to that, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Senator Warner, I'm amazed after having served with me for four years and have such low regard for my memorative powers. I'll remember the resolution.

PRESIDENT: Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: I certainly do support this and I'd like to have Senator Cavanaugh think of some way where we could have it apply to other projects throughout the state. We have one hung up there for about 13 years now. The last five it has been hung up because of the EPA. I'd like to talk to you about something along that line too. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of LR 162. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 3 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The resolution passes. Now LR 110.

CLERK: Read title to LR 110.

Mr. President, there is an amendment offered by Senator Maresh printed on page 251 of the Journal to insert a new Section 3. (Read Maresh amendment).
