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add a new section. Read amendment. See page 1488, Journal.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I'd move for the adoption of the amendment and I have checked with Senator Fowler and Senator Frank Lewis on this and we have an individual in the school retirement system, we will have many people who will get into the system after 60 years of age, if we intend to retire at 65 and they have to mandatorily get into the retirement bill, under the retirement system and they will not even have an opportunity to vest. So this is to eliminate that problem and let these people only that can vest come under the retirement system. I think it is a thing that we have overlooked and I think Senator Fowler and Senator Frank Lewis can agree, I hope. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, a question of Senator Barnett. Senator Barnett, what is the fiscal impact of this?

SENATOR BARNETT: It is zero because I am taking people out of it.

SENATOR DUIS: I still need to know, does the fiscal impact, whether it is zero or whether it goes backwards or forwards.

SENATOR BARNETT: On 673, I don't know, you will have to ask the introducer.

SENATOR DUIS: Then I would ask the introducer because I am interested in knowing. Senator Carsten has given us a complete analysis this morning of our fiscal impact on our bills and I think we are going to have to keep up to date with this as the amendments come, whether it is down or whether it is up.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I don't think my amendment has a thing to do with this and I wish you would rule him out of order.

SENATOR DUIS: Well, I am begging your pardon. I am sure that I am able to ask a question of the introducer of the bill or you in regard to your amendment as to what the fiscal impact is.

SENATOR BARNETT: I told you nothing.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fowler.

SENATOR FOWLER: I'd agree...I agreed to let Senator Barnett put this amendment on this bill. It does not directly affect the reserve teachers, which is what the bill deals with. It deals with other retirement systems and I guess this bill was the one available because it did deal with that chapter of the statutes.
