644, 645, 660, 686, 716, 718, 733, 749, 750, 764, 776,  
787, 841, 852, 911, 916 and 920 all correctly enrolled.  
Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and  
capable of transacting business, I have signed LE 296,  
643, 644, 645, 686, 716, 718, 733, 749, 750, 776, 764,  
660, 787, 841, 852, 911, 916 and 920.

CLERK: All right. The next bill is LB 987. There are  
a series of amendments on the bill. To start with, there  
are E & R amendments. Recognize Senator Dworak for  
E & R amendments to 987.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak. 987, E & R amendments.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of  
the E & R amendments to LB 937.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay.  
They are adopted.

CLERK: Now, wait. I have got a lot of amendments,  
Mr. President. The first one, Mr. President, is offered  
by Senator Koch. Senator, you have a series of amendments.  
Are they all one amendment? There's a lot of reasons  
in here. I assume that is not a part of your amendment,  
is that right, Senator Koch? Your editorial comment.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President and Mr. Clerk, these are  
a series of amendments as they relate to certain pages  
and sections throughout the bill and I believe that  
we should treat them as such. The first one, beginning  
on page 5, subsection (c), of section 9. Oh, the  
reasons, Mr. Brown, are not part of the amendment. They  
were only handed to members of the body as an explanation  
and they were just given to you in that context. We  
are only speaking, for instance, on the first one, page  
5, section 9, strike subsection (c), lines 7 to 14.  
That is the amendment and the remarks there are for the  
body when I handed this out then that day. Mr. Presi-  
dent, are we proceeding with mine?

PRESIDENT: Yes, we will take them up one at a time. Your  
first one is...

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, my first one would be on  
page 5 of the green copy of the bill which I had when  
we started all this and it is on section 9, subsection  
(c) and in there my proposal is to strike 7 through 14.

PRESIDENT: You are striking subsection (c)?

SENATOR KOCH: That is correct.

PRESIDENT: On lines 7 to 14?

SENATOR KOCH: That is correct.
