CLERK: Senator Kime voting aye and Senator Richard Lewis changing from aye to nay. Senator Mills voting aye. Senator Goodrich voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis moves that the Call be raised. All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The Call is raised. Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I think that there are two bills that we had brought back. I think....

PRESIDENT: Excuse me. We ought to record the vote ... or report the vote. What was it?

CLERK: 28 ayes, 9 nays, remainder not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We have rescinded the Duis motion of a couple weeks ago and these bills will be transmitted to the Governor as soon as they're properly enrolled.

CLERK: I have another motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright.

CLERK: I move to rescind the held over order on LB 454 and 454A, page 1217 of the Journal, and present and deliver those bills to the Governor.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, these are two bills that we did bring back from the Governor and are in this same category. I think that we formally need to release the same way. I move that this motion be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Question is the adoption of Senator Carsten's amendment ... or motion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, Mr. President, 0 nays, 18 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten's motion is adopted. We're back on Final Reading. Would all of you kindly take your chairs. We're going to commence with 687. Please take your chairs, Senators. Final Reading. All nonsenatorial personnel leave the floor. Would the Senators kindly return to their desks. We are in Final Reading. Commence.

CLERK: Read title to LB 687.

(Machine turned off)

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review respectfully reports that they have carefully examined LB 204, 579, 690, 883, 948, 972, 1007, 1008 and 1010 and find the same to be correctly enrolled. Signed, Senator Dworak, Chairman.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business I propose and have signed LB 579, 690, 883, 972, 1010, 1007, 1008, 204 and 948.
