SENATOR DWORAK: If your amendment is not adopted and the original resolution that Senator Burrows introduced ... the Foundation would have to give this to the Southeast Community Technical College.

SENATOR MARESH: I think they hesitate to give it without approval.

SENATOR DWORAK: Or sell it to them.

SENATOR MARESH: Well I think they are asking our permission to do this. I can't....

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak, there are no amendments on this. This is in the identical form that it was rejected last week.

SENATOR DWORAK: I thought Senator Maresh just got finished reading an amendment.

PRESIDENT: I ruled that out of order.

SENATOR DWORAK: We cannot amend this resolution?

PRESIDENT: That's correct.

SENATOR DWORAK: OK then the next question I have is of Senator Lewis. Senator Lewis, in your opinion will this reduce the construction needs of the Southeast Nebraska Community Technical College?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I believe it will.

SENATOR DWORAK: If the Southeast Technical College does not obtain this building then they will have to build facilities someplace else?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I can't speak for them. I just assume that if you acquire this kind of facility it would resolve a lot of your needs. I would assume it would help in terms of other capital construction plans.

SENATOR DWORAK: Has the Southeast Community Technical College requested this site?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yes.

SENATOR DWORAK: I don't understand, why cannot the Foundation sell this to them at this point?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Well I think there are some technical problems involved with it. I don't claim to be an expert in terms of taxation and conditions of sell. I do believe it would.... I believe it's important that a project like this meet some community standards for the people of Beatrice. There are some legal reasons why, I'm sure. I'm sorry, I can't answer that.

SENATOR DWORAK: Is this resolution.... Will this resolution straighten out these legal impediments in any way?
