CLERK: Voting aye Senators Anderson, Barnett, Bereuter, Burbach, Burrows, Carsten, Cavanaugh, Cope, DeCamp, Dickinson, Duis, Dworak, Fitzgerald, Fowler, George, Goodrich, Hasebroock, Johnson, Kelly, Keyes, Koch, R. Lewis, Luedtke, Mahoney, Maresh, Marsh, Marvel, Mills, Moylan, Murphy, Nichol, Rasmussen, Rumery, Savage, Schmit, Simpson, Skarda, Stoney, Swigart, Syas and Warner.

Voting nay none.

Not voting Senators Chambers, Clark, Kennedy, Kime, Kremer, F. Lewis, Stull and Wiltse.

41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 673A passes. Are you prepared to read LB 823, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes.

CLERK: I have a motion on the desk, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.
