## LEGISLATIVE BILL 847

Approved by the Governor April 17, 1978

Introduced by Bereuter, 24

AN ACT to amend section 23-1601, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to county treasurers; to impose certain duties on county treasurers as prescribed; to provide operative date; to repeal the original section, and also sections 15-825, 15-826, and 17-705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-1601, Reissue Revised of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read Statutes follows:

23-1601. (1) It shall be the duty of the county treasurer to receive all money belonging to the county, from whatsoever source derived, and all other money which is by law directed to be paid to him. All money received by him for the use of the county shall be paid out by him only on the warrants issued by the county board according to law, except where special provision for the payment thereof is or shall be otherwise made by law.

(2) The county treasurer shall prepare and file the required annual inventory statement of county personal property in his custody or possession, as provided in sections 23-346 to 23-350.

(3) On or before the fifteenth day of each month, (3) on or before the fifteenth day of each month, the county treasurer (a) shall pay to each city or village located within such county the amount of all funds collected or received for such city or village the previous calendar month, including bond fund money when requested by any city of the first class under section 2 of this act, and (b) on forms provided by the Auditor of Public Accounts shall include with payment a statement indicating the source of all such funds received or collected, and an accounting of any expense incurred in the collection of ad valorem taxes, except that the the collection of ad valorem taxes, except that the Auditor of Public Accounts shall, upon request of a county, approve the use and reproduction of a county's queral ledger or other existing forms if such ledger or other forms clearly indicate the sources of all funds received or collected and an accounting of any expenses incurred in the collection of ad valorem taxes. 865

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- Sec. 2. Any city of the first class may request that bond fund money be included with payments distributed under subsection (3) of section 23-1601. Such bond fund money shall be included in the monthly payment until notified otherwise by the city.
- Sec. 3. This act shall become operative on July 1, 1978.
- Sec. 4. That original section 23-1601, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also sections 15-825, 15-826, and 17-705, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
- Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
