SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, a question. I just now checked with the Bill Drafter. I have a bill down there. He is not certain he can even get it out by 4:30. What is the procedure from there on?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I guess then it would have to come through committee. I would say that would be the only ... or by the Governor, one or the other.

SENATOR KREMER: What am I going to do if I can't get five signers?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Well that is a problem. Unanimous con... I guess you can suspend the rules, try to suspend the rules on the floor. I don't approve of that, nor do most of us, but if it is the only way, that's the way it can be done. Senator Nichol.

SENATOR NICHOL: Mr. Chairman, do you have any idea how long we'll be in session after 4:30? Is this going to be a matter of....

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Only long enough to introduce bills, which should not take an hour.

SENATOR NICHOL: Half hour maybe?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Oh yes. Mr. Clerk, that would be adequate, wouldn't it? Half an hour would be most adequate.

SENATOR NICHOL: A few of us have the same problem of Senator Kremer and I just wanted some idea as to how long we'd be in session. Thank you.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That is about it. While we have a break here I'd like to ... Senator Rumery has a guest, Mr. Al Robinson, Chief Radiologic Technologist of the Great Plains Medical Center, North Platte, Nebraska. Would Mr. Robinson please stand up. Welcome Mr. Robinson. We will then resume introduction of bills.

CLERK: (Read title to LB 414, LB 415, LB 416, LB 417, LB 418, LB 419, LB 420, LB 421, LB 422, LB 423, LB 424, LB 425, LB 426, LB 427, LB 428, LB 429 and LB 430). That is all the bills at this time, Mr. President. Your Committee on Judiciary, to whom was referred LB 23, instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 96 General File. Mr. President, Senator Bereuter asks unanimous consent to have mass-produced amendments to LB 38.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any objection? Hearing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, two new bills. (Read title to LB 431 and LB 432). Mr. President, the Executive Board gives notice of a meeting at 4 o'clock in Room 2102 for purpose of referral of a bill. Signed, Senator Marvel. Mr. President, there is pending a motion by Senator Rumery to withdraw LB 318. The motion is found on page 240 of the Journal, and was laid over till today.
