PRESIDENT: Thank you, Senator. Do you have anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Business and Labor gives notice of an executive session today at 10:00. I think at 10:03, Mr. President. Mr. President, we have another motion by Senator Schmit to transfer LB 434 from Government Committee to Ag Committee, which I assume will just be laid over till Monday.

PRESIDENT: Yes. Senator Luedtke.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that we recess till....

PRESIDENT: Would you want to make your announcement again, I think, for the senators.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I will explain my motion. The motion is to recess until 4:00 p.m., at which time we will only meet in order to take in the announcements of hearings set by committee chairmen. We will then proceed to adjourn until Monday at 9:00 a.m.

PRESIDENT: So that there is no confusion. Debate on the matter before us will not be commenced at 4:00. That will be held over till Monday. Mr. Clerk.
