PRESIDENT WHELAN: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Marsh asked to be excused for this week. Senator Kremer asked to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do you have corrections to the Journal, Mr. Clerk? Are there corrections to the Journal from the floor?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Seeing none, the Journal shall stand. Notices, reports and announcements. I have one short announcement. There is a correction to Item 6 on your Agenda. Senator Venditte has a resolution which will be taken up immediately after Resolution #6. Notices, reports, announcements, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, a communication from the Executive Office under date of January 25th. Read communication. See page 316, Journal. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 47 and recommend that the same be placed on Select File, signed Senator Cullan, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs to whom was referred LB 35 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation that it be indefinitely postponed, signed Senator Rasmussen, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Public Health to whom was referred LB 72 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended, signed Senator Dick Lewis, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Public Works to whom was referred LB 211 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File; LB 256 General File, signed Senator Kremer, Chairman.
