

CLERK: Read title to LB 50.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 50 pass with the emergency clause attached. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 342 of the Journal). 40 ayes, 2 nays, 6 present and not voting, 3 absent and not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 50 passes with the emergency clause attached. Please read LB 85.

CLERK: Read title to LB 85.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 85 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 343 of the Journal). 43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 85 passes. Please read LB 116.

CLERK: Read title to LB 116.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 116 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 344 of the Journal). 41 ayes, 1 nay, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 116 passes on Final Reading. Senator Luedtke, do you want to make a motion.
