PRESIDENT: Select File. No, wait, Final Reading, excuse me. Read LB 82.

CLERK: Engrossed legislative...

PRESIDENT: Will the Senators please return to their desks and all nonsenatorial personnel leave the floor. We are on Final Reading. All Senators return to your desks, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schmit and Senator Kremer ask to be excused for thirty minutes.

PRESIDENT: Proceed with Final Reading.

CLERK: Engrossed legislative bill 82. Read on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 82 pass with the emergency clause attached? Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: Read record vote. (See pages 361 and 362, Journal.) Senator Mills voting aye. Senator Warner voting aye. 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 not voting, 2 present and not voting, 3 absent and not voting.

PRESIDENT: LB 82 passes with the emergency clause attached. We are now off Final Reading. We go to Select File. LB 23, Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move that the E & R amendments to LB 23 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The motion is adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, I move that LB 23 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced as amended.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, I move that the E & R amendments to LB 49 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 49 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature, I move that the E & R amendments to LB 72 be adopted.
