Second District over here in the front of this side, and the Third District in the rear of the room.

PRESIDENT: All right. So that everyone will be clear, the First Congressional District will caucus in the rear of the Chamber on the Speaker's side. The Second Congressional District will caucus in the front of the Chamber to your left and the Third Congressional District will caucus in the rear of the Chamber on your left where legislative wives quite often sit. We will be at ease, then, for how long, Mr. Speaker?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, just until we can select one person from each of these caucuses to serve on this committee to make up the two slates for the appointment by the Governor.

PRESIDENT: So each caucus is to select one.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Each caucus is to select one member for this purpose.

PRESIDENT: The first thing you shall do is select a Chairman of your caucus for purpose of nominating and selecting one member. Will you please go immediately to your caucus areas. Congressional District One is to the rear to the right hand of the Chamber. Congressional District Two is up front, left hand. Number three is the rear, left hand. We will be at ease.
