PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order.
Record your presence. Roll call. Record your presence.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hasebroock asked to be excused at 10:30 for the balance of the day. Senator Fowler asked to be excused till he arrives. Mr. President, Senator Reutzel asked to be excused till he arrives.
