SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Legislature will come to order.
Prayer by the Chaplain.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Frank Lewis asked to be
excused until he arrives. Senator Merz asked to be excused
until he arrives.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Record the attendance, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, a quorum is present.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Quorum present. Any Journal corrections,
Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, the Journal is without error.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I shall not comment on that. Notices,
reports, announcements.

CLERK: Mr. President, a report will be inserted in the
Journal as to the number of full and part time session
employees and their approximate cost. (See page 459,
Journal.) Mr. President, a rule change submitted by
Senator DeCamp. Read rule change. (See page 459, Journal.)
This shall be referred to the Rules Committee, Mr. Presi-
dent. Mr. President, your committee on Banking, Commerce
and Insurance to whom was referred LB 224 instructs me to
report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it
be advanced to General File; LB 264 General File; LB 251
indefinitely postponed; LB 279 indefinitely postponed;
and LB 289 indefinitely postponed. Mr. President, I
move to withdraw LB 27 and cancel the hearing set for
February 22. Signed Senator Keyes. That will be laid
over. Mr. President, read report of Enrolling Clerk.
(See page 460, Journal.) Mr. President, your committee
on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and
reviewed LB 117 and find the same correctly enrolled;
LB 146 correctly enrolled. Signed Senator Cullan, Chairman.

LB 117 and LB 146.
