

SENATOR DWORAK: I have a question before I can vote. I would like an answer to this question.

PRESIDENT: All right. We will hold up voting so that..

SENATOR DWORAK: It is a legitimate question.

PRESIDENT: You can ask Senator Chambers. No, no, not from the microphone because debate is closed. All right. Now record your vote. Have you all voted? Please vote. Record. Senator Chambers. Two.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I am going to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Clear the Board. The question is, shall the House go under Call? The question now is, please vote, going under Call. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 11 nays to go under Call.

PRESIDENT: We are under Call. Please return to your desks. Sergeant at Arms, find the membership except former Senator Dickinson. Don't let him in. Please record your presence. Record your presence. Senator Savare. Senator Maresh. Senator Barnett. Senator Cope. Would the Sergeant at Arms determine the whereabouts of Senator Labedz and Senator Schmit. Senator George, change your vote to present, please. Call the roll.

CLERK: Mr. President, roll call vote taken. (See pages 504 and 505, Journal.)

PRESIDENT: The Clerk cannot hear the responses. Could we have more order on the floor.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. 22 ayes, 25 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Marsh moves that the Call be raised. Record your vote on that. Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. We now go to General File. LB 64.

CLERK: LB 64 introduced by Senator Chambers of the 11th District. Read title. There are no committee amendments. There are some other amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes had advised me that he wanted to raise a point of personal privilege and I overlooked that. Senator Keyes. Senator Keyes, you advised the Chair that you wanted to raise a point of personal privilege. Would you state the point to the Chair please.
