

SENATOR MARVEL: Have you all voted?

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays to go under call.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion carried. The House is under call. Record your presence. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Bereuter voting aye on the original motion. Senator Fitzgerald voting aye on the original motion.

SENATOR MARVEL: The pending motion is to advance LB 179 to E & R for Review. Clerk will call roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote.

SENATOR MARVEL: Clerk announce the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 12 nays Mr. President on motion to advance.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion carried and the bill is advanced to E & R for Review. Senator Chambers do you want to make a motion to advance 179A?

CLERK: Read LB 179A. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The A bill does just what the Clerk stated when he read it off. It funds the program that was just voted and I move that it be advanced to E & R Initial.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a second to the motion? The motion and second is the advancement of 179A to E & R Review. Is there any further discussion? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays on motion to advance.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Lewis, you vote aye to advance the bill? The 179A is advanced to E & R for Review. The motion is to raise the call. Is there a second? All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting aye. 32 ayes to raise the call.

SENATOR MARVEL: The motion is carried and the call is raised.

CLERK: Read LB 182. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.

SENATOR MARVEL: 182. The Chair would like to take this opportunity to introduce to the Legislature guests under the North Balcony Mr. and Mrs. Myron L.
