SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to LB 227 be adopted.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 227, as amended, be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. I move that LB 396 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 138 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The E & R amendments are adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there is a request to bracket 138 and 138A until February 22nd. Signed, Senator Richard Lewis.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. We have some amendments suggested for 138. I've asked to have those published in the Journal so that everyone has a chance to look at them. Then I'd like to place these amendments on 138 on Select File. For that reason I ask to have it held until Tuesday.

PRESIDENT: That is a request for unanimous consent. Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman, members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 88 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.
