

President, a new bill, LB 92A. Read title. Mr. President, a further motion.

PRESIDENT: All right, now we go to Item #7 on your agenda. The first motion is by Senator Barnett to revive LB 20 notwithstanding the action of the committee. Senator Barnett.

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is, you read it, to place LB 20 on General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, for the luck I am having on legislation this year and as controversial as some of these issues are, I am going to withdraw that motion and not even take it up.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered. We go to Item (b). Senator Nichol. Your request to withdraw LB 470 and cancel the hearing.

CLERK: Read motion.

SENATOR NICHOL: Do I need to speak on it?

PRESIDENT: That is your choice. You will be very popular if you don't. It does require a machine vote, though. Record your vote on Senator Nichol's motion. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays on motion to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The hearing is cancelled and the bill is withdrawn. Now do you have two other things, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Mills offers the following motion. Read motion. (See page 554, Journal.)

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, is it time to talk about that?

PRESIDENT: Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, the Legislature did pass LB 191 on Final Reading. However, there was a part in there that I thought that we should bring to your attention concerning a part of a county that is not in the brand area and that is what LB 191 relates to. LB 191 allows by petition a county that is not in a brand area, an entire county, to become into the brand area by petition. It takes a certain number of petitioners to come into the brand area, which is fine in the intent of the bill, LB 191. However, there are several areas in the State of Nebraska that are part of counties which are not in a brand area. Now those part of counties have no way to become part of the brand area and I have placed on your desk the amendment to LB 191 which simply says that any part of a county that is not part of a brand inspection area but within a county which is part of such an area may have the same privileges as you already have passed on LB 191 for the rest of the counties that are contiguous. So I think it is important that what is good for all of the county, all of the counties involved, is certainly good for part of the county and you actually are disenfranchising those persons who in
