SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The question then is the return of LB 30 for a specific amendment, namely, the DeCamp and others amendment and a roll call vote has been requested so proceed with...Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: My light is on. I would like to pose a question to you. The question is not a debate on this issue.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: If this vote is successful and this bill is brought back to Select File for a specific amendment and then there are changes that are proposed in the DeCamp amendment, then in effect, we have got to move the bill back and bring it back, is that right?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: That is correct.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. (See page 632, Journal.)

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Maresh. Senator Maresh changing from no to aye.

CLERK: Senator Maresh switching from no to aye. 25 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The bill has been returned for the specific amendment.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I said I wouldn't take it up and I would ask unanimous consent to leave it there until such other time that we do take it up.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All right. It is now in the position of having been brought back for this specific amendment and you will take it up at your request then or at the request of the body. The Chair recognizes Senator Barnett. For what purpose do you...?

SENATOR BARNETT: Only to state that I would hope that we would have a division of the question when it comes up, and if I am not here to ask that, I hope that it is made a record that it will be asked.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: It is still the same problem. It is brought back for this specific question, and unless somebody can find a rule that allows us to divide that question when it is brought back, the Chair would have to continue with its...

SENATOR BARNETT: I think you could ask the Rules Chairman and he would tell you it is right.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: What's right? The division. The Chair will rule on it when it comes up again, whichever, so we will proceed then with Final Reading. LB 410.

CLERK: LB 410. Read on Final Reading

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Record the vote.
