CLERK: Record vote taken. (See page 633, Journal.) 44 ayes, 2 nays, 3 not voting.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 410 is passed with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Read the motion, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read motion. (See page 633, Journal.) Signed Senator Warner.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, LB 477 is a bill that corrects the appropriation for state aid to schools that you will recall was a mixup between the special session and the regular session last year. This has a pay out date of March 1st as it was originally drafted. It ought to be enacted today. It can be enacted today. The Governor is in concurrence with the bill. DAS has been alerted so that the pay out can be made, and otherwise, we may have to pull it back and revise the wording. So I would hope the body would go along with reading the bill today.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? It requires 30 votes to suspend the rules. Senator Mills. The Chair recognizes Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, is this to suspend the rules that will eliminate holding the bill on Final Reading?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This allows, because of the fact it could not be read until tomorrow unless we suspend the rules, it may be read with the suspension of the rules today.

SENATOR MILLS: Do we have to suspend another rule because of the DeCamp motion that was made earlier this year, holding those spending bills?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: I believe Senator DeCamp specifically mentioned an exception on these kind of bills. I may be incorrect but I believe there was an exception stated. Senator DeCamp, is that not correct that these deficiency bills and bills that Senator Warner specifically referred to would be excepted anyway? This was Speaker's order anyway, Senator Mills. This was left up to the Speaker's order. The motion for holding these bills on Final Reading was left up to the Speaker's order and the Speaker will rule that unless this body decides to the contrary that this is one of the bills that was under the exceptions offered by Senator DeCamp and Senator Warner when the matter was first discussed. Any objection to that? All right, if not, the motion is to suspend the rules to take up for Final Reading LB 477 with the emergency clause. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays, to suspend the Rules.
