SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The rule is suspended and LB 477.

CLERK: LB 477. Read on Final Reading.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached? Record the vote.

CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 634, Journal.)
43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 2 absent and not voting.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 477 is passed with the emergency clause attached. The Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I would ask that LB 477 be expedited in order that it can be placed on the Governor's desk today.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Are you asking unanimous consent that it be expedited?

SENATOR WARNER: Yes.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. The bill will be expedited.

CLERK: Additional reports.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Proceed, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 129 and find the same correctly engrossed. Signed Senator Cullan, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Public Works to whom was referred LB 402 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended; 181 indefinitely postponed; 463 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Kremer, Chairman. Mr. President, Legislative Resolution #17 will be placed in the Journal expressing concern by the Legislature on claims on policies pursued by officers of the State of South Dakota and the claim of right by that state of certain lands along the Missouri River. That is all, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We will also take this opportunity to introduce 6 members of the Political Science Class from Chadron, Senator Cullan's District, over here under the North balcony. Mr. Schafer I believe is the instructor. If they will stand up please, right under the North balcony, right over here. Welcome to the class. We will then proceed with the special orders of the day and we have two of them as you will note on the agenda. The first one is that all appropriation bills take precedence under special order under our rules and Senator Warner we have three appropriation bills to be brought up on General File under special order. If you would, Mr. Clerk, are you ready for the three bills? LB 479.

CLERK: LB 479. Read title. There are no committee amendments or other amendments pending.
