SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 172 passes with the emergency clause attached. The Clerk will now read LB 183.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 183.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Has everybody voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on page 657 of the Journal). 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 183 passes. The Chair wishes to announce that LB 255, which is on Final Reading today, was inadvertently omitted from the agenda and will be read at this time. LB 255.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read title to LB 255.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read record vote found on pages 657 and 658 of the Journal). 43 ayes, 0 nays, 3 excused and not voting, 3 present and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 255 passes.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Read the motion.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read F. Lewis amendment found on page 658 of the Journal regarding LB 443).

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I'm not really trying to hurry the bill along. It doesn't have the emergency clause on it, but I will be gone tomorrow and I have a great deal of interest in this particular bill. It's the climax of the Constitutional Amendment and bill to implement that. I would like to be present to vote. It's very short and I'd ask that the rules be suspended and we can read that now.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Is there any discussion on Senator Lewis' motion to read LB 443 on Final Reading today? If not, all those in favor.... It requires 30 votes to suspend the rules. Motion to suspend the rules. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record the vote.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to suspend the rules.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The motion to suspend the rules passed and we will now read LB 443 on Final Reading.
