

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to suspend the Rules and consider LR18 at this time. Signed, Senator F. Lewis.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator F. Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, the intention of the Resolution speaks for itself. I would ask that the Rules be suspended so that we may take it up.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? Motion is to suspend the Rules to take up the Resolution. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote nay. It requires 30 votes. Record the vote.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the Rules.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Rules are suspended and the Resolution is before the House. Chair recognizes Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I will be brief. Certainly I know that each and everyone of you want to express the same sorrow that I do to our good colleague, Bill Burrows, on the death of his mother. His mother and father are almost institutions in that part of the state and his father of course served in this body and I would ask for the adoption of the Resolution.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion? If not, all those in favor of the Resolution regarding the death of Mrs. Burrows will vote aye, opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: The Resolution has been adopted.

CLERK: Read Senator F. Lewis motion regarding Request No. 802.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator F. Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, this particular request from the committee comes from a meeting held sometime back with the Sutherland Board of Education that has faced a very serious problem in terms of a drastic increase in enrollment due to temporary employment at the Gentleman Power District Plant. Senator Rumery instigated the meeting, invited me to meet with some members of the Board and the Administration, and I did. After reviewing the problem with a substantial number of increases and a very small school it appeared that some solution was necessary. I have conferred with NPPD officials and they have reviewed what we are doing and we would like to introduce the bill and give it a full public hearing and come back to discuss with you the resolution for this small community and Lincoln County with a problem. I would ask that the bill be introduced.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: A question please of Senator Lewis. Senator Lewis is this a temporary situation? If I am correct it is during time of construction.

SENATOR LEWIS: Yes, that is absolutely correct. We have put
