

PRESIDENT: Schmit's bill of 81, 81A will be held over, Schmit's 77 is held over, how about the "Sunset Law"? DeCamp is gone, Banking, DeCamp is gone. Richard Lewis, Bingo and Senator Reutzel is here, Senator Clark is here Senator Goodrich is here, Frank Lewis is gone. So that we can...so that you will know what bills are coming up we will start with the eighth bill down, LB100 and we will go from 100 to 176 to 401 to 180 to 199 to 275 to 205. Then we will see where we will go from there. Alright, Senator R. Lewis on LB100.

CLERK: Read LB100.

PRESIDENT: Senator R. Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, do you want the chairman of the committee to handle the committee amendments?

PRESIDENT: Who is that?

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Senator Kremer.

PRESIDENT: Alright.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. President, what we would like to do is to hold this bill but we would like to adopt the committee amendments as some of you know and some of you might not know there is a great turmoil in the public power industry in the State of Nebraska. This legislature has been bombarded with bills each particular section and entity trying to further their own advantages. Yesterday in an early morning meeting we had a very candid discussion over many of these areas. There has been a committee appointed of three legislators and six people from the industry to try to resolve some of these issues. I have promised the people in the industry to hold this bill in position until they have had an opportunity to work out some of the things that are at issue. I would like to have the committee amendments adopted and hold LB100 on General File.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the legislature. There will be those in the State of Nebraska that will view this move to accept amendments to LB100 contrary to the best interest of the quality and peace that we are trying to establish in the power industry in Nebraska so that we can get some rhyme and reason to this war that is going on. I caution you Senator Lewis again, things should set where they are and by doing any work of any kind on LB100 will be misconstrued by different sections of the power entities in the State of Nebraska I implore you please, do not amend LB100 at this time. Do not touch LB100 in any way, except with brackets.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, to those of you in the membership who are not as aware as some of us are on the Public Works Committee as to the controversy that is going on in public power today, I would have to take the position because this is the position that I have taken to bracket LB100 where it is without any amendments. Senator Lewis, I'm sorry if you want to move for the adoption of the committee amendments, I will yield to you. But, in staying with my
