

to \$150 and this was sort of a compromise. We had two bills on Workmens Compensation and the other one had a \$168 figure and we felt that by compromising with the \$150 figure and kill the other bill and advance this with the \$150. I move that this amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the committee amendments? The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature I move we advance LB275 to E & R Initial. This brings the maximum pay-out available under workmens compensation to a more realistic level, at a very realistic small premium increase.

PRESIDENT: Senator Brennan.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Mr. Chairman, I had what I thought was a reasonable bill in the committee but I deferred to the committee and put a kill motion on my own bill so that we could get a decent bill out on the floor that would pass. I would ask for a suspension of the rules. We could have a roll call vote on the committee amendments. That only takes 30 votes doesn't it?

PRESIDENT: That matter is not before us now. We have a valid motion now which must be disposed of. You can do that on Select File Senator.

SENATOR BRENNAN: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The matter before us is the advancement of the bill. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record. Yes, Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: (mike not activated) votes and I'll have to ask for a Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the House go under Call. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays to go...

PRESIDENT: The House is under Call.

SENATOR KELLY: A roll call vote please.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All Senators please return to your desks and all non-senatorial personnel leave the floor. Please record your presence. Senator Swigart, please press your button. Senator Duis. Senator Goodrich. Would the Sergeant at Arms please find Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers is the only member missing Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I was hoping that we would pick up those three votes to stop this Call. I would withdraw the roll call request, so we can...

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye. Senator Newell voting aye. Senator Newell already voted aye.

PRESIDENT: Good try David. We are receiving votes, he took
