LB 219, 224, 267, 268

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See pages 762 and 763, Journal.) 45 ayes, 0 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 219 passes. Please read LB 224.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 224. Read on Final Reading.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 224 pass. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Record vote read. (See page 763, Journal.) 47 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 224 passes. Please read on Final Reading LB 267.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Motion on the desk, Mr. President. Read. (See page 764, Journal.) Signed Senator Frank Lewis.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, the purpose of doing this was that in order to make the information a little more update we picked September 1 but the Board of Trustees are elected in SID Districts the second week in September. So that the information would be more current, I am simply changing those two dates to be consistent dates to September 30 from September 15 and September 10 respectively. It is a very minor change and I would ask to bring the bill back and insert those two date changes. Again it is a matter of fifteen, twenty days difference but it will make the information more up to date and more current. So I would ask you to return the bill for that purpose.

PRESIDENT: The question is....

ASSISTANT CLERK: The amendment reads as follows: Read. Reread.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the bill be returned for the specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 46 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Yes, I am sorry. We now go to LB 268.

ASSISTANT CLERK: LB 268. Read on Final Reading.
