PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes called for the previous question. Are there 5 seconds? The question is shall debate now cease. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Hefner, do you want to close debate?

SENATOR HEFNER: Are we closing on the amendment?

PRESIDENT: Yes.

SENATOR HEFNER: I don't have anything more.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. The question is the adoption of the amendment. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Frank Lewis, for what purpose do you ask recognition?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I will defer to the Speaker before I make the motion because he's supposed to make the motions.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I'm going to make the motion and I'm also going to say that if you don't want to meet for the rest of the week, let's not meet at all. Let's just have, for the rest of the week, committees meet and get their work finished, and then let's come back next week and go to work. If that is the way you want it, I think that is what we ought to do. I think this is ridiculous, fooling around this way. There are only two committees that had scheduled anything this afternoon. There were plenty of people here to conduct business on the consent calendar. If you don't want to vote, of course, you can't operate. We're wasting time, wasting your time and my time. I'm going to move that we adjourn until Monday at 9 a.m.
