

of all the states around us. So instead of \$50 to file a case, I moved it back to \$35 and as you can see the other changes cut in half or a little better most of the increases. I would urge adoption of the amendments. The effect of the amendments would be as follows: it would increase the fees somewhat, not nearly as much as they proposed. This would result in a certain amount of property tax reduction, while not making the courts inaccessible through excessive fees. I move adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I also talked to Senator Kahle about this bill and I'd ask him, would he be willing to bracket it and I think he said til Wednesday of next week he would. He had amendments at that time, but I hadn't had a chance to go through them and gather the kind of information that I wanted myself. What I'm rising for at this point, if he doesn't object, would be could we go ahead and bracket it until Wednesday?

PRESIDENT: Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: I have no objection to bracketing until Wednesday.

PRESIDENT: Ask for unanimous consent to bracket this bill until Wednesday. Is there an objection? Seeing none, it's so ordered. We go to LB 230.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 230 the E & R amendments have been adopted as of March 9. The bill was then laid over. There are some additional amendments to the bill. The first one is offered by Senator Savage. Read amendment. Signed Senator Savage.

PRESIDENT: Senator Savage.

SENATOR SAVAGE: There has been some confusion as to what these different funds were, whether cash or general, so in order to identify it and to have no argument about it we added the cash fund so they can operate with that cash fund. I move its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Is that on the amendment, Senator?

SENATOR SAVAGE: Yes.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of the amendments to LB 230. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, there are further amendments offered by Senator Barnett. Read amendment. Signed Senator Barnett.
