PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Swigart's amendments to LB 22. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 13 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.

SENATOR SWIGART: Mr. President, I move to advance the bill as not amended.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced as not amended.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a motion to suspend the rules and set some bills for hearing this next week, offered by Senator Warner. I move to suspend Rule 3, Section 5 and set the attached bills for public hearing. Signed Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President. This would almost be seven days; it's next Thursday. These were a series of essentially corrective bills that the Appropriations Committee turned in that would allow them to be shown in the Sunday paper. I would not anticipate anybody who would appear at a hearing, but in the event that there might be we wanted to hold one. If we could set that Thursday, it would be better than a Friday date.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is shall our rules be suspended so the Appropriations Committee can set certain hearing? Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended Senator Warner.

CLERK: Now Mr. President Notice of Committee Hearing. The Appropriations Committee gives notice of committee hearing. Signed Senator Warner. Mr. President, we have a new bill...

PRESIDENT: Before we get on that, I would like to introduce friends of Senator Kuhle in the North Balcony, Mr. and Mrs. Donald Chavana, Jackie, Terry, Cathy, Patrick and Kelly and Mr. Gene Geisler from Pleasanton, Nebraska. Thank you for being here.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new bill offered by Senator Brennan, read LB 302A Mr. President, an explanation of vote. Had I been present I would have voted aye on LB 103. Signed Senator Marsh. That's all Mr. President. Mr. President, Senator Merz asked to be excused Monday until he arrives. Now Mr. President, a motion on LB 125. I move to return LB 125 to Select File for specific amendment. Read amendment. Signed Senator Simon.

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
