

PRESIDENT: Senator Simon.

SENATOR SIMON: This, Mr. President and members of the Legislature, was really an oversight on my part. Senator Kahle and I talked about it and we believe that the county should be able to utilize whichever method whether it's certified or registered. It's also my understanding that certified mail is cheaper, so this merely gives them the option of which they care to use.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is shall this bill be returned. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on motion to return.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned. Offer the amendment please Senator.

SENATOR SIMON: I am adding the words, my amendment which was adopted on the 8th, I'm adding the words "or certified" after "registered". So the amendment would read "by hand or sort by registered or certified mail". I've discussed this with Senator Kahle whose bill this is and he is in complete agreement what this is just a simple procedure that would save the counties money if they care to use this method.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Senator Kahle.

SENATOR KAHLE: This is correct. We had inadvertently left out this word. It should be in there.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of this specific amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendments are adopted. Would you, Senator Kahle, would you please advance the bill?

SENATOR KAHLE: I move we advance LB 125.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB 88 to Select File for specific amendment to correct the E & R amendment as follows: Read amendment. Signed Senator Cullan.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. As I understand this particular E & R amendment, it was a mistake made in the E & R process as an amendment came to the desk. This just clears up the language and says for four periods, as I understand it. I would move it back for that specific E & R amendment. I have talked to Senator Labez and she understands that should have been the way the E & R amendment should have been introduced. I would move to move LB 88 back for specific amendment.
