

CLERK: Senator Newell changing from no to aye.

SENATOR MARVEL: Who do we have besides the Budget Committee? Senator Reutzel, do you want the Budget Committee in? Okay. Ray. Sergeant at Arms, will you go contact the Budget Committee. There is a Call of the House. Senator Kremer, we are under Call of the House.

CLERK: I move to advance 109A.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Maxey, the vote is on the advancement of 109A. Do you wish to vote? Senator Maxey votes aye. Senator Fowler votes aye. The motion is to raise the Call. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no.

CLERK: Senator Marsh voting aye on the original motion.

SENATOR MARVEL: The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 20 ayes, 2 nays to come out of the Call.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion carried. The Call is raised. Clerk announce the vote on the advancement of 109A to E & R for review.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Motion carried. Bill is advanced. Senator Murphy, are you ready to take up LB 45. Let's read in some material from the Clerk's desk first.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Works to whom was referred LB 510 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File. Mr. President, Senator Barnett asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 109 and then Senator DeCamp asks to print amendments to LB 109. Mr. President, Senator Koch asks to have inserted in the Legislative Journal a resolution for consideration tomorrow. That is all, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: The Chair recognizes Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. Chairman, this is a series of three bills which should be discussed back to back and I think it would be futile to start at this point in time. I would ask that they be laid over until tomorrow. There is no way we could accomplish all three of these.

SENATOR MARVEL: What is the pleasure of the Legislature? Mr. Speaker, what is your pleasure?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: We are going to continue right on down the line, then. We have almost a half an hour and if you are going to keep doing this, you will sure be here for a long time.

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Murphy asked unanimous consent that we pass over 45, 46 and 98. Is that your request, Senator Murphy? Is there any objection? If not, so ordered. The next bill is LB 79.
