LB 79, 79A

CLERK: Roll call vote on page 861 of the Journal. Senator Kremer voting no. 12 ayes, 27 nays Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails. Senator Savage moves the call be raised. Clear the board. Record your vote on that. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 15 ayes, 18 nays to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. The call is not raised. We're under call. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members. I move that LB 79 be advanced as amended.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: If there are no other lights on, I won't move the previous question. Otherwise I will. I move previous question.

PRESIDENT: Do I see five seconds? The question is shall debate now cease. Record your vote.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. The question is shall this bill be advanced. Clear the board. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 13 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Senator John Savage moves that the call be raised. Record your vote on that proposition. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 10 nays.

PRESIDENT: The call is raised. Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: May we have the A bill now?

PRESIDENT: Yes that's next.

CLERK: Read LB 79A. There is an amendment on the desk. I move to amend 79A, strike Section 2. Signed Senator Cope.

SENATOR COPE: Mr. President, members. Let me read Section 2. "There is hereby appropriated three hundred fifty thousand dollars from the State Building Fund and all available federal and private funds for th fiscal year ending June 30, 1978, to Kearney State College, Program No. 914, to construct a Nebraska Safety Center facility on state-owned property." That leaves a balance that we're asking for this year in the A bill of \$54,000.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak. (No response). Senator Mills.

SENATOR MILLS: Yes, will Senator Cope, does Kearney have a Program No. 845? Is this a new program then? Do they have 845?
