

SENATOR MARVEL: Any further discussion? We're voting on the Duis amendment to LB 109. All those in favor vote aye, opposed vote no. Twenty-five votes. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: I would hate to have to have a Call of the House. I believe there are more people here than what are here. I would hesitate by standing here for just a few moments, and if they would please vote.

SENATOR MARVEL: We are voting on the Duis amendment to LB 109. Have you all voted? Have you all voted?

SENATOR DUIS: I don't know, Mr. President, if everybody has voted yet. There seems to be 20.... Okay.

SENATOR MARVEL: Clerk, record the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 5 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR MARVEL: Before we take up the next motion, I have a note here that the Superintendent of the Milligan Public Schools, Mr. Ken Mahlon, is under the North balcony. If he's still there will you raise your hand. Do we have another amendment to LB 109?

CLERK: Yes. (Read Maresh amendment found on page 892 of the Journal).

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Maresh, you have three amendments. We'll take them up one at a time?

SENATOR MARESH: It has to do with the same thing.

CLERK: Read amendments.

SENATOR MARESH: I think we could just strike Sections 9 and 10, Mr. President. That last part is additional language that shows up in Section 9 and 10 pertaining to the same amendments. I think those sections would no longer apply to the bill if we adopt this amendment. What this does....

SENATOR MARVEL: Excuse me just a moment now. What are you proposing?

SENATOR MARESH: What I'm proposing is that the habitat part of ...the 20 percent that is allocated for the habitat part of it be stricken and 100 percent go to the parks.

SENATOR MARVEL: Now where is your amendment?

SENATOR MARESH: It is on each members desk. Let's adopt the first one and then it will just fall into place.

SENATOR MARVEL: Okay, your motion is the adoption of your first amendment. Have you distributed copies of your amendment?

SENATOR MARESH: Yes, Mr. Speaker, I did. No, it's in the green copy, page 4 in the green copy.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is it in the bill book?
