LB 311, 311A, LR 32,
LR 33, LB 398, 312

CLERK: 29 ayes, Mr. President, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 398.

CLERK: Mr. President, there's an A bill to 311. Read LB 311A.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Question of Senator Moylan if he'd yield please. Senator Moylan I see that the appropriations measure \$218,000. Is this provided for in the Welfare Department's budget? Has it been allocated or is this new money that we're talking about that will be in excess of what we know some of our projected revenues and budgets will be this year?

SENATOR MOYLAN: Well, honestly, I can't answer that. I believe it would have to be another appropriation because it is matching money for federal funds also. I couldn't answer that right now. I'll try to get the answer for you...

SENATOR STONEY: This is not an item that was included in the Governor's budget?

SENATOR MOYLAN: I wouldn't know. We never went into that and I don't know whether it is or not.

SENATOR STONEY: I see, thank you Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: I move the advancement of the bill.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. Any further discussion? Record your vote. Please vote. Mr. Speaker unless we can keep 25 people here, we can't even get anything done on the consent calendar. Record the vote. Report it.

CLERK. 25 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The A bill is advanced. Do you have something Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, we have two resolutions put in by the Appropriations Committee. One calling for the Appropriations Committee to serve as an interim study committee to investigate the salary comparison to the University of Nebraska salary level salary levels between campuses, questions, desirability, of a formula approach, etc. It will be referred to the Executive Board. Legislative Resolution No. 33 introduced by the Appropriations Committee calls for a study to study salary comparison of the trustees of the state colleges. That also will be referred to the Executive Board. That's all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kahle is absent today, so we'll pass 398 and go to 312.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 312. Read LB 312. There are committee amendments, Mr. President, signed by Senator Richard Lewis, chairman of the Public Health and Welfare Committee.
