SENATOR DUIS: How much less than \$30,000?

SENATOR WARNER: How much less?

SENATOR DUIS: Than \$30,000?

SENATOR WARNER: That's one of the reasons for the contractual relationship, but I suspect it will be very close to that.

SENATOR DUIS: OK, I just wanted to check. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: The question is the advancement of the A bill. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The A bill is advanced. We go to LR 8.

CLERK: Mr. President, Legislative Resolution No. 8 which I'll read is found on page 399 of the Legislative Journal. The statement is found on page 747. Read LR 8.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move that the resolution be adopted. This will not need to be...if it's adopted today, Mr. President, it's not a resolution that needs to go across the board.

PRESIDENT: You want this as a bill don't you? We're treating this as a bill?

SENATOR WARNER: No.

PRESIDENT: We can adopt it if we want.

SENATOR WARNER: We can adopt it today and it will be dependent upon the bill being enacted in the final analysis to be effective.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Any further discussion of this resolution? I noted that there was great interest in it when it was being read, Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: There will be.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of this resolution. Record your vote. Senator Swigart.

SENATOR SWIGART: Just ask Senator Warner to please in his own brief words explain what it's all about.

PRESIDENT: We're voting.

SENATOR SWIGART: I was half way trying to listen, but it got kind of thin and I couldn't hear very good.

PRESIDENT: Well, record the vote. We're going to adjourn at 4:30. LB 462.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.
