ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 88.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is shall the bill pass with the emergency clause attached. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record the vote Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read record vote on pages 915-16 of the Journal. 42 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting. Senator Schmit voting aye. 43 ayes, 0 nays, 4 excused and not voting, 2 present and not voting Mr. President.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: LB 88 is passed with the emergency clause attached. Clerk read LB 125.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Read LB 125.
