SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Duis brought up a point that we inadvertently left...Senator Maresh is there any reason why LB 30 should not be brought up on Select File. It inadvertently has been left off of the agenda. Is there any reason why it cannot be brought up?

SENATOR MARESH: Mr. Speaker, Senator DeCamp was the one that brought the bill back. I'm waiting for him to come up with an amendment and that's why it hasn't been taken up. Why don't we bracket it for March 29?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: You're asking unanimous consent to bracket on Select File til March 29. Is there any objection? Senator Simon, do you object?

SENATOR SIMON: Mr. Chairman, as I understand it, we brought it back. We don't have to have a specific time that we bracket it to, do we?

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Yes, the point being that it's there on Select File and is at the head of Select File and should be taken up unless it's bracketed to a date certain.

SENATOR SIMON: I understand that. I would oppose that. I think the matter will be brought up shortly, but I would oppose to bracketing to a specific date at this time.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Maresh.

SENATOR MARESH: I move it be bracketed for March 29.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Any further discussion on that point? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Question of Senator Maresh if I might please.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Will you reply?

SENATOR DUIS: Nothing in particular except is there any reason that you picked the date of March 29?

SENATOR MARESH: No, it's on a Tuesday and I thought the members should be here on a Tuesday. Usually we have a good representation and the votes would be...a proper vote would be taken.

SENATOR DUIS: We couldn't take it up on the 22nd?

SENATOR MARESH: What day is that?

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
