LB 81, 81A, 79, 79A, 77

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: This is a motion, or unanimous consent request by Senator Reutzel to bracket LB 81 and 81A until the 21st. Is there any objection to the request to bracket? If not, so ordered.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move that LB 79 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: There are amendments Senator Cullan. Motion to adopt the E & R amendments.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move that the E & R amendments to LB 79 be adopted.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 79. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the E & R amendments to LB 79 vote aye, opposed nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, now there's a request by Senator Cope to bracket LB 79 and 79A till March 23.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: Senator Cope, unanimous consent. Is there any objection to Senator Cope's unanimous consent request? If not, so ordered. LB 77.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are no E & R amendments on 77. There's a motion to indefinitely postpone the bill offered by Senator Murphy. Mr. President, that's first being offered so it will have to lay over. That has to lay over one day.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: There is a motion to indefinitely postpone. The motion, as I understand it Senator Murphy, has not been laid over one day on your motion to indefinitely postpone. It has to lay over one day according to the rules. Senator Murphy would you like 'o...Chair recognizes Senator Murphy on his point.

SENATOR MURPHY: I believe I delivered that motion to the Clerk on...

CLERK: Yesterday, but the bill doesn't come before us until today. It wasn't before us so you can't take up the motion, it comes up today for the first time.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: It has to lay over today.

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine.

SPEAKER LUEDTKE: In other words, if the rule means anything it's that when it comes before the House, that it would lay over for a day on that particular motion. Senator Schmit, do you want to speak to this matter?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I would Mr. President. I would just like to find out if it's possible to know as nearly as possible when the bill might be coming up on Monday because I have a daughter that will be undergoing surgery on Monday and I will not be here part of the day. I know that Senator Murphy would be interested in acting on this expeditiously and I would like to accomodate him.
