SPEAKER: The Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I rise for two reasons. First of all, I would announce that had I been present I would have voted for 275. Secondly, I rise on a point of personal privilege to read a little mail in.

Further that the Executive Board of the Legislative Council submit a report of its study and findings along with any recommendations for corrective legislation to rid the act of inconsistent, inappropriate or unnecessary language thereby rendering the act more responsive to its declared intent. That, Mr. President, will be referred to the Executive Board. Mr. President, Senator Bereuter would like to make an announcement relative to the Appropriations Committee.
