LB 126, 401, 264, 45

CLERK: 26 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Now Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move that LB 126 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. 401.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are E & R amendments.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move the E & R amendments to 401 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, there is an amendment offered by Senator Warner as follows, read amendment on page 989 of the Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move adoption of the amendment. I had visited with Senator Clark and at one time indicated he agreed with the amendment. All it does is that it insures that this special committee would not act as a Standing Committee during the session and hear bills as a Standing committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Clark says that's alright. That's the question, the adoption of Senator Warner's amendment. Record your vote. Please vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes Mr. President on motion to adopt.

PRESIDENT: Senator Warner's amendment is adopted. Senator Cullan.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature. I move that LB 401 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. 264.

CLERK: The next one up is LB 264, Senator Burrows has a motion to indefinitely postpone. That will lay over one day.

PRESIDENT: LB 45. Senator Murphy's bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 45. There are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan. Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: If I may, I have discussed this with Senator Luedtke. There is much debate that can be spared the floor in the meeting that has been recommended, however, Senator Chambers has been severely tied up with a particular piece of legislation and the group that agreed to meet and discuss this has not been able to do so. With the Speaker's approval, I would ask that the bill be bracketed til Wednesday and save a lot of discussion here on the floor.

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
