SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I move that LB 473 as amended be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

SENATOR KEYES: I would like to have the Revenue Committee meet right over here for about three minutes.

CLERK: 419. Mr. President, there are E & R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cullan. E & R amendments on 419.

SENATOR CULLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the E & R amendment to LB 419 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. They are adopted.
