

SENATOR DWORAK: So canoes really are the only type of boat that we're including that were not included up to this point.

SENATOR SAVAGE: As far as I am aware of yes.

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Savage, there are a lot of people shaking their heads no and I'm not going to ask you any more questions, but I wish some of those people that are...

SENATOR SAVAGE: I said up to my knowledge, if there's somebody else that has more information, you can ask them.

SENATOR DWORAK: Could I ask Senator Simon a question? He seems to be knowledgeable in this area.

SENATOR SIMON: Do you want to ask me the same question?

SENATOR DWORAK: Yes, I'd like to know what boats we're including now that have not been included before.

SENATOR SIMON: Senator Savage, I had written and asked the Game and Parks Commission about this because I had an inquiry. Their response to me was every single vessel, rubber rafts, innertubes, anything, I have sent down for...I have sent down to my office to get a copy of the letter that I sent to a constituent but it says everything. The reason for that, Senator Dworak, is because they want it for identification purposes. The Coast Guard had asked in the case of stolen property and in case somebody fell out of a rubber raft, that they would know who's rubber raft it was, who drowned or who's body to look for. So it is every single vessel of any kind, innertubes, whatever.

SENATOR SAVAGE: It doesn't mean these rubber rafts that the boys and girls use in a swimming pool. It doesn't include that.

SENATOR DWORAK: But what kind of rubber raft...

SENATOR SAVAGE: A big rubber raft, that you would float down the Missouri River.

SENATOR DWORAK: But if you use in a swimming pool, it's not...but if I put it in the river it is. Is that correct? Where it's used? Senator Koch has...

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. President, to answer Senator Dworak if he would read Section 49 & 50, those are exclusion sections. I don't think I should read them to you because you're very capable. You were always a speed reader and you comprehended 99%.

SENATOR DWORAK: Senator Koch, I guess the thing that bothers me is on the pink sheet, on page 3 there is wording and I did read it. I see wording that is conflicting with that in 49 and 50. Maybe you could bring that in...

SENATOR KOCH: In 50 I think it will clarify your question Senator Dworak and I didn't mean to be witty. It says the commission by rule and regulation will exempt a vessel from numbering and other types of activities, if they find that the numbering on certain types of vessels will not material
