

the same monies that were listed and some additional ones may be used by the NRD, but you have dropped the connotation that it must be for the purposes that we have specified in the act and I wondered if that was by intent, if we are releasing them from the designations of this act or if it was an oversight and we really should leave the word in there. Let them have the additional sources of income but continue to hold them, to using them for the purposes set forth in this act.

SENATOR KREMER: In my understanding of the bill, this certainly was not the intention.

SENATOR MURPHY: Would it be well to reinstate for the purposes of this act...are we releasing them to use monies, cash funds particularly, that might digress from this act?

SENATOR KREMER: No, Senator Murphy. That's all been taken care of. They operate exactly like they have been the last few years. The only problem we've had that the old obsolete language has never been stricken. You are referring, of course, to the new language on page 14, is that right?

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes, and it drops where you've added the new source of cash funds, you dropped the restriction that all these funds must be used for the purposes of this act. I guess I'd kind of like to keep the NRDs confined to activities that we have set forth in this act for expenditures.

SENATOR KREMER: Of course, the new language has in carrying on its operations, but your problem is will those monies that became available to them be used for the purpose for which they were collected. Is this right?

SENATOR MURPHY: I'd just like to reinstate for the purposes of this act.

SENATOR KREMER: I'd have no objections to this at all.

SENATOR MURPHY: Fine. I'll offer an amendment to possibly pick it up on Select File, Senator.

SENATOR KREMER: Why don't you let it move on Senator Murphy to Select File and we'll check that out.

SENATOR MURPHY: Yes, that's what I said. I'll be happy to do that.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, now I have become curious about this bill and I'd like to ask Senator Murphy a question. Senator Murphy, when you were talking about these funds, the NRD funds, does that mean that you're going to offer an amendment that will say that they cannot join in with the Game Commission in providing habitat?

SENATOR MURPHY: This, they do have a great deal of latitude, Senator, but I do not propert to change the approved intent of the act. It simply is that we have designated that they may receive these outside funds and use them. I want to say use them for the purposes set forth in the act. I don't want an unfortunate latitude to creep in there and I have no other desire.
